

FYEG 2023 General Assembly Call for Members of the Advisory Committee



Deadline for application: Last day of the General Assembly (14th of May 2023)

The Advisory Committee (AC) is composed of 5 people elected to serve for 2 years and fulfill the following tasks and duties:

- Provide their shared experience on a specific subject upon request by EC members or other bodies of FYEG, in order to ensure transfer of knowledge,
- Assist in conflict resolution between EC members, members of other bodies and/or personnel upon request by EC members or other bodies of FYEG,
- If requested by the EC, advising the EC on organisational and structural matters.
- Present a brief overview of the functioning of the EC and personnel at the General Assembly.

Members of the AC are people that have held positions within FYEG, especially as members of the Executive Committee.

Three members of the AC have been elected in 2022 (Wanja Kaufmann, Stefanie De Bock, Teo Comet) which means their mandate ends in 2024.

Two members have been elected in 2021 (Sam Murray, Mina Jack Tolu), which means their mandate will end in 2023.

Two positions are therefore open for re-election in the 2022 General Assembly, of which at least one must be filled by someone that identifies as woman (cis or trans) and/or trans and/or genderqueer.

These positions are voluntary, and therefore not paid.

Applications

- Candidates for the Advisory Committee can apply until the last day of the General Assembly (May 14th).
- Outgoing EC members may advance their candidacy for the Advisory Committee before the GA or while the GA is still in assembly.
- The newly elected EC will then, towards the end of the GA, select two from the pool of candidates, and present the candidates to the GA.
- The GA will then either approve or reject the two candidates, based on simple majority voting. There is only one vote, meaning that the candidates are approved or rejected together.
- If the candidates are rejected, the new EC must immediately select two new candidates and present them to the GA.
