ECOSPRINTER EDITORIAL BOARD REPORT 2019-2020



The goal of this report is to make a summary and an evaluation of the activities of the Ecosprinter for the 2019-2020 period.

The Ecosprinter Editorial Board published 20 articles in the 2019 - 2020 period and recorded one podcast episode on the situation in the Amazonas in late 2019. During the mandate the main outcome of the work of the Editorial Board in close cooperation with FYEG's Office was the editing and publication of the 1st printed edition of the Ecosprinter in 2020 titled [Reclaim Your Rights! The Social Rights Issue](#).

There was one change in the team compared to the 2019 GA results, as Cristiana Cerri Gambarelli resigned from her position when she started working in FYEG's Office, and was replaced by Dr Sam Murray following a call for new members. The team's initial enthusiasm, and thus regular meetings decreased during the mandate, especially following the COVID-19 pandemic.

The previously started [Europeans At Work blog](#) saw two articles published during the mandate. The continuation of the blog is advised to the next Editorial Board as the ongoing pandemic has affected working conditions quite dramatically, so the theme of the blog is as important as ever.

ARTICLES

Out of the published 20 articles, 2 were part of the Europeans At Work sub-blog, 4 were interviews (3 with recently elected young non-male Green politicians), 2 were external contributions from a student and an NGO representative and 12 were contributions received for the 2020/1 printed edition.

PRINTED EDITION

The Printed Edition was partially an outcome of the FYEG's 2019 year-long project on social rights, from which activities some of the articles were coming from. The rest were collected following a call for contributions on FYEG's website. The final edition is an outcome of the joint work of the Editorial Board, of FYEG's Office and of Sarah Heim as editor and Beka Buchashvili as typesetter and designer.

PODCAST

In November 2019 the Ecosprinter recorded a podcast with Greens/EFA MEP Anna Cavazzini, Paulo Barreto, a Brazilian and Jean Paul Benavides, a Bolivian researcher to understand the ongoing situation at the Amazonas. The recording will be available on the Ecosprinter's Soundcloud account.
