CALL FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Deadline for application: last day of the General Assembly (tbc)

The **Advisory Committee (AC)** is composed of 5 people elected to serve for 2 years and fulfil the following tasks and duties:

- Provide their shared experience on a specific subject upon request by EC members or other bodies of FYEG, in order to ensure transfer of knowledge,
- Assist in conflict resolution between EC members, members of other bodies and/or personnel upon request by EC members or other bodies of FYEG,
- Present a brief overview of the functioning of the EC and personnel at the General Assembly.
- Members of the AC are people that have held positions within FYEG especially as member of the Executive Committee.

Two members of the AC have been elected in 2019 (Maria Kola and Zuzana Pavelkova) which means their mandate ends in 2021. Three members have been elected in 2018 (Markus Drake, Laura Carlier and Kim Van Sparrentak), which means their mandate will end in 2020.

Three positions are therefore open for re-election in the 2020 General Assembly, of which at least one must be filled by someone that self-identity as a woman, trans or genderqueer person.

These positions are voluntary.

Members of Advisory Committee (AC) have:

- full one-way access to the email-list of the Executive Committee throughout the year, i.e. are allowed to follow conversations but not to react on them,
- further access to communication within the EC and personnel upon request of the EC and/or personnel, e.g. attending an ECM or phone conferences,
- are obligated to treat all communication between EC members and personnel confidentially,

APPLICATIONS

Candidates for the Advisory Committee can apply **until the last day of General Assembly (tbc)**.

Outgoing EC members may advance their candidacy for the Advisory Committee before the GA or while the GA is still taking place.

The newly elected EC will then, towards the end of the GA, select three from the pool of candidates, and present the candidates to the GA.

The GA will then either approve or reject the 3 candidates, based on simple majority voting. There is only one vote, meaning that the candidates are approved or rejected together.

If the candidates are rejected, the new EC must immediately select 3 new candidates and present them to the GA.
