## 1. FYEG Strategy (Moderator: Özge) | 10:15-11:00

### a. Discrimination within FYEG

Training for the EC and FYEG should be prioritised. Office to follow-up  
Gender budgeting needs two people working on. Office to follow-up

### b. Support to movements

Beneficial to have some pax from movements but not the overwhelming majority (set a %). We do not ask people to go on strikes but we support and promote people who do.

Wanja: I applied for a job in Amman, Jordan. If I get that job I will be in Jordan if not I will run again. I know in February. I want to focus on MO Strategy and Action Plan, planning the study visit, compiling the individual and MO strategy and making some plans for the next operational year. I also would like do something with the policy responsibility before the GA

Eli: Figure out Young Candidates Platform and the Communication Strategy, it would be nice to finish. I am not sure about FYEG as it's been two years but I like the other green plans questions because I want to understand what I can do for the Greens on a national side. Maybe try to influence Green Party of England and Wales or learn French and joining Ecolo or learn Dutch and join Groen. Continue the Global Greens.

Milan: I would like to focus Democracy and Inclusion WG and East MO strategy. I feel I didn't live up to my expectations but I would like to start making sense of the East. To run again, I would personally like to but I am also not sure as I have been struggling with the professional aspect of my life. It takes a lot of energy to be a volunteer and I still can't give myself fully as I can't be stable financially. I also applied for a job in Serbia and I also want to live abroad for some time.

Gülce: I want to focus more on feminist network, cause last month I couldn't do much, Political Platform and MO Forum are my three priorities. I am not planning to run again as I have a contract right now and then would like to start a master's degree.

Liam: Go back to my motivation letter and see what is achievable from there and what has not been achieved. I would like to get the awareness training completed for the EC and Staff. Mo-Mo training another priority. Depending on my work and my studies and I want to get a phd and focus on that.

Clara: Consent resolution, getting it to the EGP Council. COP26 campaign and preparation of the delegation. Mental health protocol. I am not sure whether I run again as I will start my master's programme next year. I don't know if I can balance both work.

Mina: Political Platform, I would like to contain the hippie strategy energy and transfer it to the political platform and also the italian strategy. Of course I have other tasks that I will continue. I will not run again. I am thinking of perhaps to be a candidate for the next EGP Committee, and at the start of summer I will be a candidate in Malta to make the list diverse.

Stef: I made a plan during my lunchbreak. I know from last year the second part of the mandate is MO Fees I really want to solve one of the difficult MOs and try to get the Germans in a good place and finalise EC remuneration. The movement strategy is an important for me. I don't know what will happen in May and if I will run again but definitely my time as a treasurer is done. I am a little bit scared of leaving as I have been distancing myself from Groen.

Ozge: first year was so crazy - I wish I had the insights I have now, because I would have focused on strategy straight away. I would like to finalise MO strategy (i am so happy about this work), strategy, HR guidelines (it will make it much easier for next office), fundraising strategy. I already said I will run again to finalise these things and stay only one year. I decided I will stay in Brussels, I can't go back to Turkey. When coming from Eastern Europe and realising how difficult from FYEG it is to do something for EE - with Gulce and Milan's help. This midway is very challenging, and to this EC I am just so amazed by the work and hope we can share pizza with pineapple.

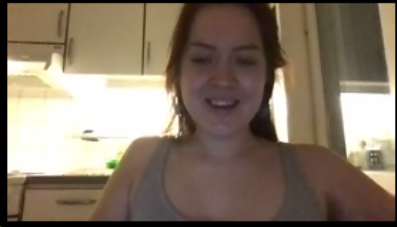
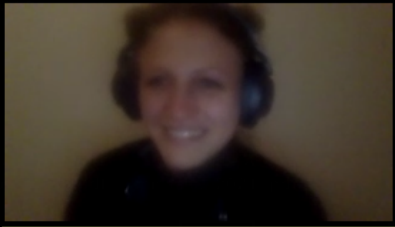
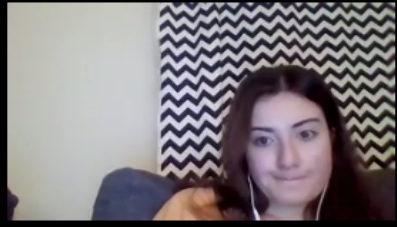
